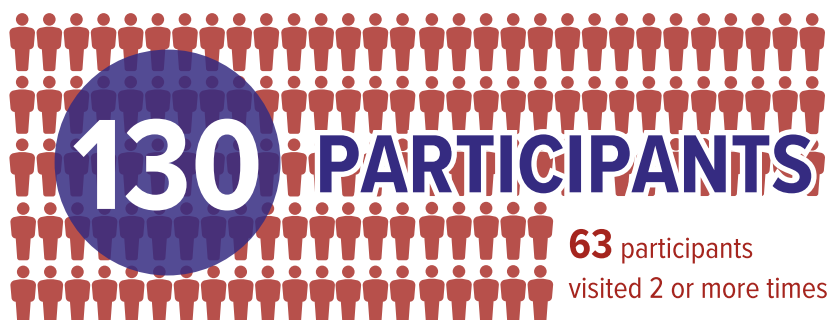

About the Participants

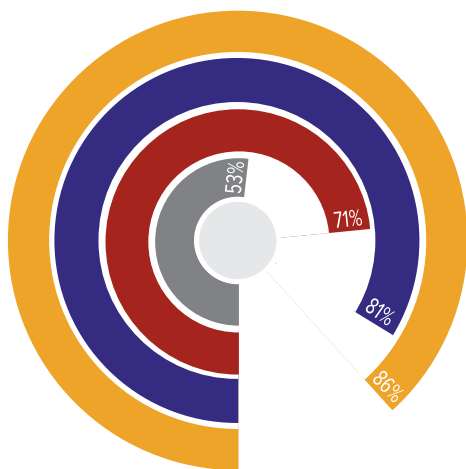


53% live with someone else who injects drugs
